To join the adventure, players can either print a game sheet from home or pick one up at any of the participating locations. The objective is simple: spot the mini Dolly cut-out, inform the store staff at the register where Dolly is hiding, and earn a stamp on your game card.

Once you get 15 stamps, you'll be eligible to enter to win a prize at the Where's Dolly party on February 1st at 2:00 p.m. at Caterpillar Café.

If you collect all 20 stamps, you'll be entered for a chance to win the grand prize.

All completed game sheets must be turned into Adventures Underground by January 31 to be eligible for a prize. Please note that participants must be present at the party on February 1 to win.
